DEAR ESTEEMED CLIENT,

Welcome to the first Newsletter of 2026. This edition of our newsletter will feature important information about your Fund's performance. We will also provide an update on the Fund's initiatives in an attempt to create economic value during the period under review.

The LAPF's Management and Management Committee (Board) continues to manage the Fund in terms of good governance principles and their resilience generally continues to yield good results.

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Monthly Pensions

As a result of improved income flows mainly from pension contributions and property rental collections during the year 2025, the Fund's liquidity position has generally improved and monthly pension payments remain up to date.

Pension Adjustments

The Fund's Management Committee (Board) granted a 14.03% pension increase on your ZWG monthly pension effective 1 January 2025. The cumulative pension increase awarded by the Fund from 1 January 2020 to 31 December 2025 was approximately 2,3 million %.



December 2025 Pension Bonus

The Fund granted a once-off cushioning pension bonus for the year 2025 to all pensioners and beneficiaries who were in receipt of pensions as at 30 November 2025. The bonus, which was equivalent to 50% of one month pension, was processed together with the December 2025 pension payments.



USD Pension Payments

The Fund paid USD monthly pensions on a quarterly basis during the year 2025. Notification for collection messages were sent by Banc ABC using the Bulk payment system. The payment of monthly pensions in USD continues to be dependent on the availability of the required resources. It is the Fund's strategic objective to continuously improve the pension benefits in order to cushion its pensioners and beneficiaries.

Life certification / Annual Declaration Form

Confirmation of pensioner's existence is the purpose of completing and submitting the Life Certificate/Annual Declaration form. To avoid unnecessary inconveniences associated with the temporary suspension of pension payments, it is your responsibility to ensure that this form is completed and returned to the Fund within the specified timeframe. When completing the Life Certificate/Annual Declaration form, we kindly request that you provide your cell phone number and details of your next of kin. The Fund has a high number of pensioners and beneficiaries whose records were suspended due to non submission of Life Certificate/Annual Declaration forms.

Children's Pensions

If you are in receipt of a child's pension for a child who has reached the age of 18 years and is still attending full time education, please submit a letter of confirmation from the educational institution clearly stating the date of commencement of studies to ensure continuation of pension payments. Kindly note that the child's pension will be paid up to the age of 23 years provided an annual confirmation letter is received by the Fund.

Change of Pensioner/Beneficiary details

Kindly notify the Fund of any changes to your banking details, phone number as well as address by completing the required Details Update Form by the 7th of the month for the change to be effected in that month's pensions payroll. The form can be collected from the Fund's offices, your nearest member Local Authority or downloaded on the Fund's website www.lapf.co.zw
